Adult 5k starts at 8:30 am so race times will be prompt. Races are free, for the experience & untimed.

Course: Both races will finish down White St at the 5k finish line in front of the Waterville Public Library.

¼ Mile: Kids will run in a straight line, starting at the railroad tracks on White St and straight down to the finish. Meet at the railroad tracks to start.

1 Mile: Kids will start at Memorial Park Elementary School parking lot, and follow the 5k course (E. Bacon St to Elmwood Ave to White St) to the finish line. Meet at the Elementary School Parking Lot by the Baseball Field. Shuttles will run to this location later in the day (starting 10 am) if you're staying at Cruisin'. Parents can drop kids off to the Kids Run Adult Volunteer and go closer to the finish to watch.

Race Morning: Bib Pickup will be from 7-7:30 am at the Firemen's Pavillion next to the 5k Pickup. Please pick up your bib and arrive to your start area by 7:50 am. Bibs can be picked up in advance at the Waterville Public Library Sept. 12-16. A ribbon & refreshments will greet you at the finish.
